





DIFFERENT KINDS OF NON-PRACTICAL CATHOLICS:-


- 1. The **ignorant Catholic** he may be brilliant in other fields, but he has long since ceased to weigh and to reflect life's daily concerns in the light of faith. As a result he cannot answer the simplest questions about his religion and he will hardly use his religion even for his own salvation or holiness...
- 2. The mechanical Catholic he is fairly faithful to Friday abstinence and attendance at Mass, but his faith means little to him otherwise. He fulfills his obligations simply because Catholics are supposed to do certain things. His Catholic living therefore is of little or no inspirational value to others. He rarely says a prayer, seldom attends any evening devotion. From such as these arise the great scandals in politics, business, or social life, that bring discredit to the Church . . .
- 3. The **protestant Catholic** who quite callously disagrees with the Church usually on the subjects of marriage and the necessity of Catholic education. Very often such a Catholic is too ill-informed to know that he is disagreeing, not with the Church, but with God and His law, and that he is plunging himself into heresy . . .
- 4. The apologetic Catholic who seems constantly fearful of what the world around thinks of him and his faith. He nods approval, or gives silent consent, to the most outrageous statements about his religion. Sometimes he startles even non-Catholics by his remarks: "Of course, the Church teaches that, but most Catholics don't agree with her." Such Catholics do no good to themselves, the Church or the world at large.
- 5. The **critical Catholic** who is often tolerant of faults in his immediate circle of friends, or family, or himself . . . but he demands perfection in everybody else. Of course he talks, regardless of whether his audience is Catholic or non-Catholic, heedless of whether he misrepresents, calumniates or gives scandal.
- 6. The bad Catholic who does the most harm. It is a tribute to the Catholic religion that most non-Catholics expect a virtuous life of every Catholic. If a Catholic fails, particularly if his sins be public, the world professes to be shocked hypocritically maybe but the fact remains that any Catholic can cause immense ruin to others by a sinful life . . .
- 7 The fallen-away Catholic Actually it is impossible to destroy the seal of Catholicism on one's soul, for baptism leaves an indelible mark. But the mystery is why some "fallen-aways" hate the Church as much as they do. Possibly they are like the unfortunates in hell who, obstinate in evil, will go on for all eternity hating God, their companions and themselves. Such apostates frequently do a great amount of harm to the souls of others. They are miserable, and stand in critical need of prayers.

On these pages we also see many newcomers. We welcome them all. We wish them success. We promise them cooperation.
