This, in our reckoning, will be in 1962 A. D. or *Anno Domini*, which means in the year of Our Lord. But other people reckon differently.

In Moslem countries, it will be the year 1381. Their calendar begins from the time of the Hegira, when Mohammed fled from Mecca to Medina.

In India, it will be officially the year 1884 of the Saka era.

In Abyssinia, and those parts of Egypt which observe the Coptic Calendar it will be 1678.

It will be the year 5722 in Israel. The Jews reckon their years from the era of the Creation. This, they maintain, occurred in the autumn of what the Christians calculate to be the year 3760 B. C. That is why the Jewish New Year always falls in the autumn.

And lastly, in Japan this is Showa 35. Except that the Japanese number their years in epochs, their calendar is identical with ours. Each epoch begins with the accession of an Emperor.

At times the emotions tend to dictate to the mind and sway the heart. Christ was very much aware of this. Although He entered the world as a little child in rather heart-breaking circumstances, He came well-announced by the prophets as the Messiah of truth and left no doubt in the mind of man that he would be "destined for the fall and for the rise of many in Israel, and for a sign that shall be contradicted." He wanted no one to follow Him for emotional reasons alone. No one was to love Him because of a sentimental attractiveness, but because of the great drawing power of truth.

Looking at the Baby Jesus in the Christmas Crib may indeed draw sentimental sighs of joy; gazing into the bloodshot eyes of Christ dying on the cross may stir a deep sense of pity and compassion. But between the crib and the cross Jesus Christ taught the truth about life, its origin, its purpose, and its destiny, that no amount of sentiment could make us accept. Life was not to be lived according to the emotions; morality was not to be determined by personal feeling nor popular demand; truth was not to be twisted to meet an individual's convenience.

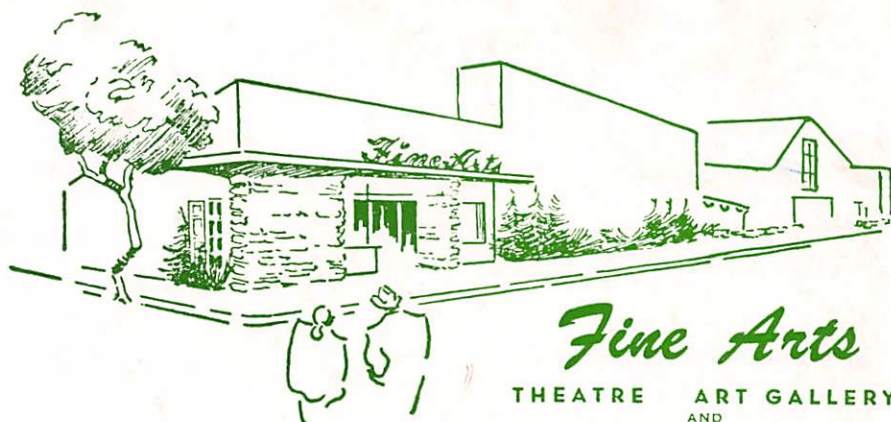
