



WATER FACILITIES:
 Water Works built 1890 & owned by town. Gravity & direct pumping system. Supply taken from White Pond, located 3 1/2 miles S.W. of Post Office & at an elevation of 15 above Pumping Station, having an area of 64 acres. Water flows by gravity through 12 main to receiving wells at Pumping Station, combined capacity of wells 280,000 gals. Water is then pumped by system through 12 pipe by 1 Blake pump of 1 million gals capacity per 24 hrs. Blake pump 1/2 million gals capacity per 24 hrs in reserve, surplus goes to reservoir located on Summer Hill, 1 mile N.W. of a 200 above Street at Post Office. Capacity of reservoir 6 million gals. Pressure at Post Office 50 lbs. per sq. inch. 12 miles 4" to 12" cast iron W. Pipe. 110 hydrants. Daily consumption 252,000 gals.

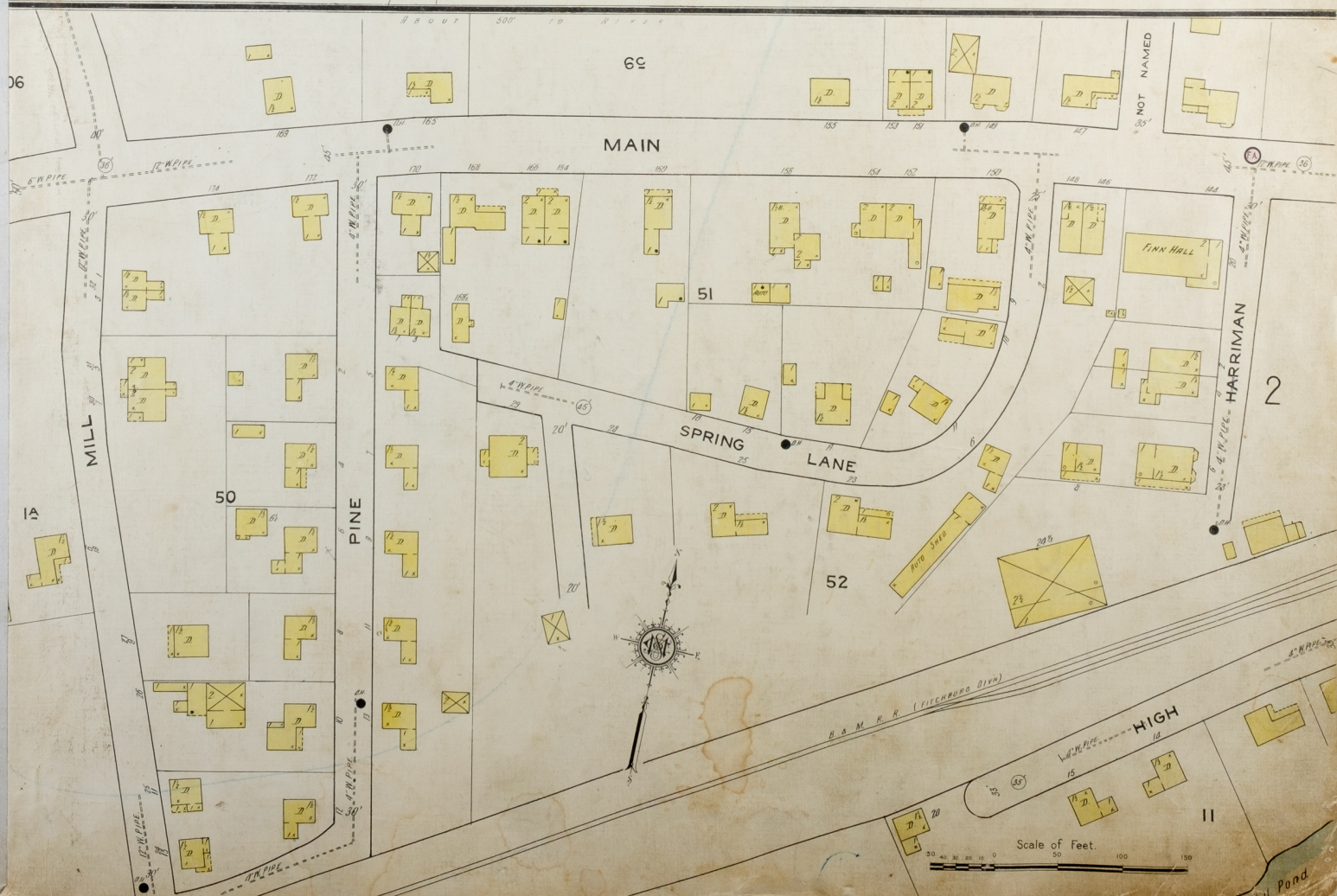
FIRE DEPT:
 1 Station, 31 Men, 2 fully paid remainder volunteer. 1 Auto Combination Horse & Chemical Truck. 1 Hook & Ladder Truck. 1 Hose Cart. 2 permanent horses. 3200' C.P. hose in good condition. Gamewell fire alarm system, whistle & bell. 16 fire alarm boxes. Streets mostly paved & lighted by electricity. No fire limits.

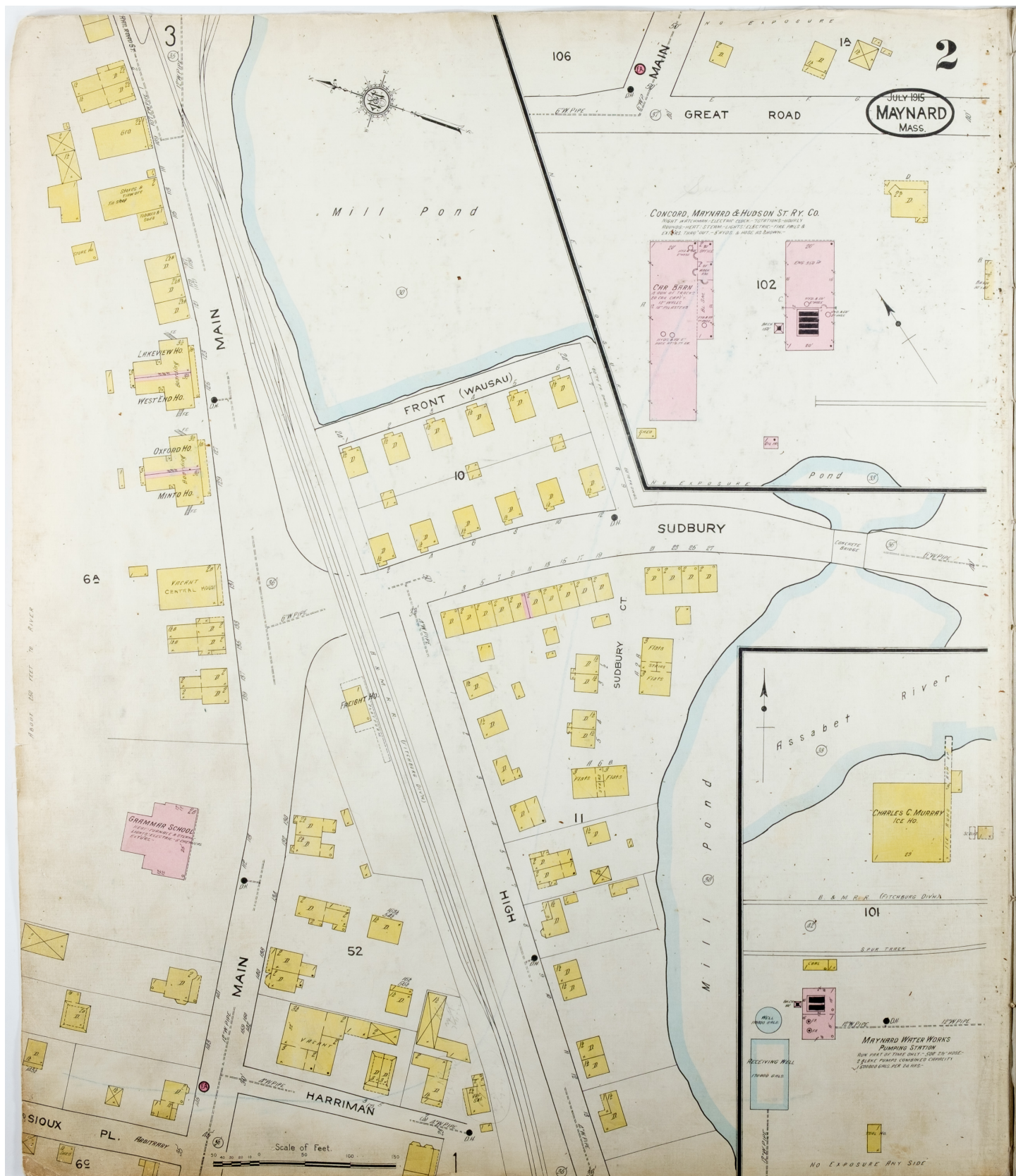

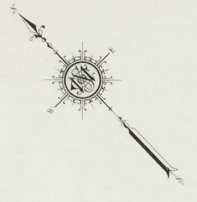

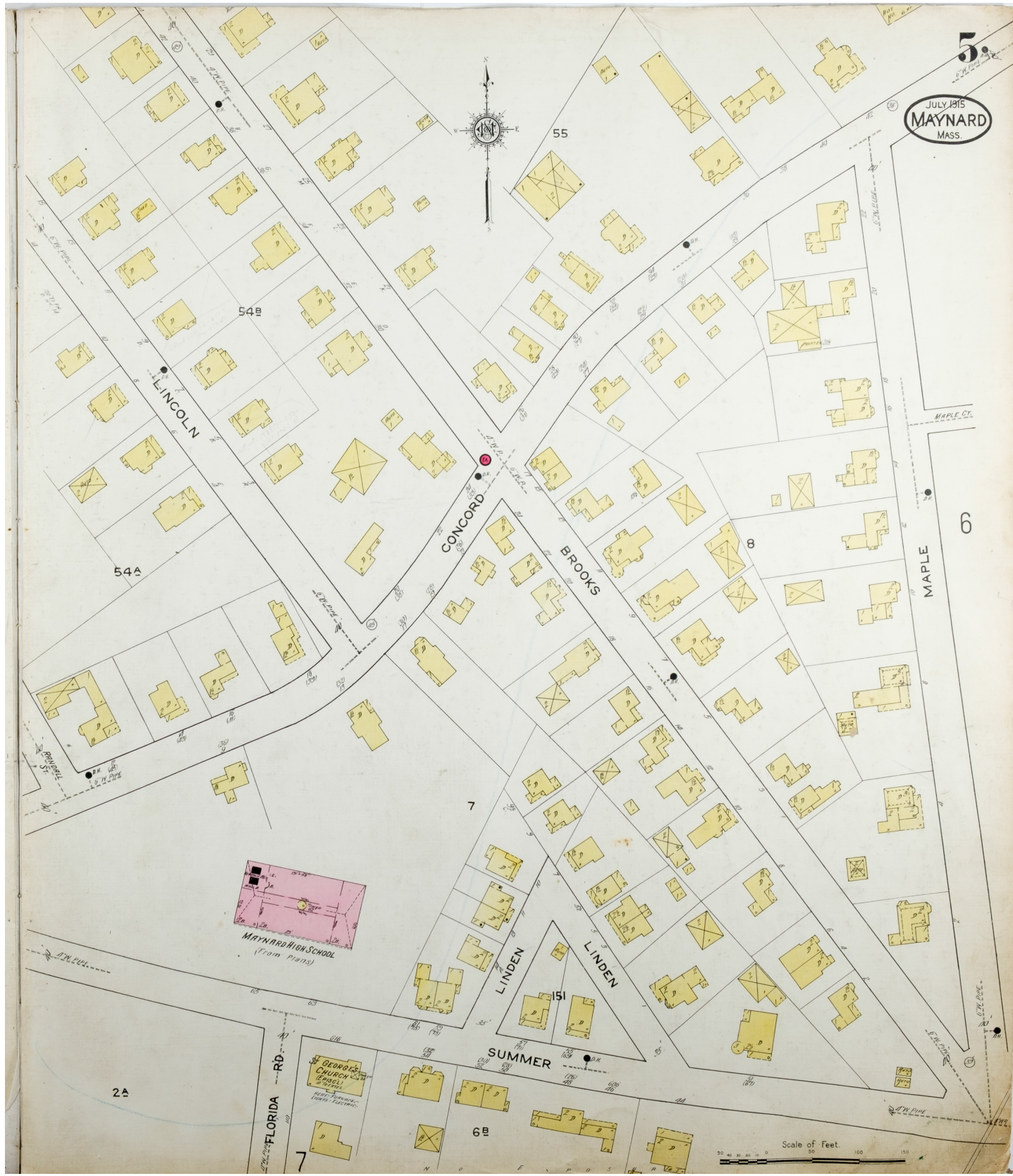
